1. Course Work Examination Result: A student course work examination will be divided into two sections – Research Methodology and Subject Specialization. The grade pattern with respect to the marks obtained will be as per below details,

2. Assignment – Research Paper: The Subject Expert shall evaluate the research paper on basis of the parameters mentioned in the evaluation sheet. The paper shall be related to the research topic. The research paper shall be related to the Ph.D. research topic and shall be submitted as part of the assignment component.
3. Conference/Seminar Presentation: The University shall award full score that is 100 marks to the student on production of original certificates of conference/ seminar participation and copy of the same shall be submitted to office by the candidate.

Formula to Calculate CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average):

If C(i) is credit of course i and the grade point secured by the student is G(i). In that course, the CGPA is given by the formula,

$$CGPA = \frac{\sum^n C_i G_i}{\sum^n C_i},$$

Where sum is over all the 'n' Courses taken in all the subjects.

To be eligible for furthering research a student should score minimum of 5.5 CGPA in the Course Work.
